Learner Referrals

I am pleased to say that since the last newsletter, I have assessed 5 new learners. The referrals have come from a range of agencies: the Job Centre, Family Action Programme, a social worker at Dean House, Rooftop Housing and Green Square housing support so it is good to see that the awareness raising being carried out by Megan's contacts team (see below) is trickling through.

Coaches

We have about 8 people on our waiting list at the moment who would like to do coach training so that's very encouraging. As with our learners, people have heard about FRED from a variety of places – existing coaches, library, local newsletters, leaflets, internet search. We are planning to run more training probably in August or September.

Additional Venues

We now have 2 additional venues available for FRED use. Lydney Town Hall has a newly refurbished room which we can use free of charge. Mitcheldean Community Library is also very keen for us to make use of their premises and have been very helpful in tracking down additional reading books to add to their shelves. Watts in Lydney has also intimated that they may be able to help. It is heartening that whenever I mention FRED, I always get a positive response and people pull out all the stops to help.
