## **Learner Referrals**

We currently have 12 working pairs. I have had a little flurry of referrals over the past few weeks and have managed to match up most of them. The referrals have come from a range of places again: Lydney Gateway, Forest Upcycling Project (Cinderford), Turning Point Roads to Recovery (Cinderford). There has been quite a bit of coming and going recently on the coach/learner front for various reasons so the number of pairs has stayed about the same despite the new referrals.

#### Coaches
